The undersigned, respectively the president and the secretary of COMPAS, INC., a corporation organized under and subject to the provisions of the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317, DO HEREBY CERTIFY that the following resolutions were adopted effective as of June ___, 1987, by the unanimous written action of the members of the corporation, consisting of the same persons that constitute the Board of Directors.

RESOLVED that Article IV or the corporation's Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

"TA

The location of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Minnesota is 75 West Fifth Street, Saint Paul."

RESOLVED that an ARTICLE XI is hereby added to the corporation's Articles of Incorporation to read in its entirety as follows:

"XI

The management and direction of the business and affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board The number, qualifications, term of of Directors. office, method of election, powers, authority, and duties of the directors of the corporation, the time and place of their meetings, and such other provisions with respect to them as are not inconsistent with the express provisions of these Articles of Incorporation shall be as specified in the Bylaws of the corporation. the members of the Board of Directors of the corporation shall be the only members of the corporation. director of the corporation automatically shall become and be a member of the corporation concurrently with his or her becoming a director, shall continue to be a member of the corporation for so long as he or she is a director, and automatically shall cease to be a member of the corporation concurrently with his or her ceasing to be a director of the corporation. The Board of Directors shall have voting rights only as directors and shall have no voting rights as members."

RESOLVED FURTHER that an ARTICLE XII is hereby added to the corporation's Articles of Incorporation to read in its entirety as follows:

Any action that the Board of Directors could take at a meeting may be taken without a meeting by written action signed by the number of directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the board at which all directors were present; provided that all directors must be notified of the text of the written action prior to the signing by any of the directors."
